

**ORDINANCE NO. O-25-42**

**COUNTY OF CROW WING, STATE OF MINNESOTA**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 92: SPECIAL EVENTS UNDER TITLE IX**  
**GENERAL REGULATIONS OF THE JENKINS CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**The City Council of the City of Jenkins does ordain as follows:**

**Purpose and Intent:** The purpose and intent of this ordinance is to adopt into the Jenkins Code of Ordinances, Title IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS, Chapter 92: SPECIAL EVENTS.

**Section 1.** Chapter 92: "SPECIAL EVENTS" is adopted and shall read:

**Special Events:** A special event generally means any temporary event with a gathering of at least 100 individuals held on public or private property in a way that brings people and activity to the site that does not normally occur. Special events include, but are not limited to, fairs, carnivals, festivals, outdoor concerts, parties, filming of a movie or television show, street dances, races, walks, athletic events, or other entertainment or celebration events.

Special events shall be divided into three categories:

- a. City Special Events are defined as follows: An event organized and conducted by the City, largely funded by the City, or affiliated with the City. These events are required to adhere to the rules outlined in this policy but will not be required to obtain a Special Event Permit.
- b. Non-City Special Events are defined as follows: An event organized and conducted by a non-profit organization as defined under Section 501(c)(3) through (10) of the Internal Revenue Code, a for-profit organization or business, or individuals. These events are required to obtain a Special Event Permit and pay applicable fees. The number of special event permits issued for a single location is limited to no more than four events in one calendar year.
- c. Exempt Events: Private gatherings (life events), including but not limited to baby showers, graduation celebrations, birthday parties, and family reunions, held on private property or within designated residential areas, shall be exempt from permit requirements, providing they do not exceed established noise, occupancy, or public safety regulations. Exempt events of 100 or more individuals are limited to no more than four events in one calendar year.


**Section 3. Repeal:** This ordinance shall repeal all ordinances inconsistent herewith.

**Section 4. Effective Date:** This ordinance adoption shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication according to state law.
